DETAILS OF SUBMISSION

The specific provisions of the proposed Plan Change that my submission relates to are as follows:

PC 44 – Temporary Events

My submission is that:

We organised the jousting tournaments at Harcourt Park from 2003 to 2015 and we are looking to resume them in 2020 – probably on a larger scale using most if not all of Harcourt Park.

I have read through the proposed new Temporary Events Plan Change and I think they are very good – there is a good balance between the amount of ‘compliance’ work that an event organiser has to do and ensuring that an event is run well with minimal disruption to those nearby.

I only have one comment:

1. There seems to be no provision for keeping animals that are part of an event at a Council park or facility – in particular the overnight agistment of animals. Being able to keep our horses overnight in carefully placed temporary stables has been of great benefit to us. If we had to transport horses off-site in the evenings and onsite in the mornings of each day that the event is run would make running our events more difficult than they already are.

I assume that the omission of this means that it is still OK for us to keep horses onsite for the duration of our event (Friday, Saturday and Sunday).
